

Daily Family YMCA of Bixby Church Coed Volleyball Rules

I. League Classification

- A. Church Coed/Recreational – has little to no volleyball experience: obvious violations called as season progresses.

II. Team/Player Requirements

- A. *Number of players* – Minimum of four players to play, with maximum of 10 on the roster. You may add to your roster up until the 3rd game.
- B. *Player status* – Attends said team's church and not participating at the collegiate or professional level.
- C. *Multiple teams* – Players are not allowed to play on more than one team per all coed leagues.
- D. *Rosters* – Team captains must report any roster changes to League Coordinator and changes are allowed up until the THIRD week. After the third week of play rosters are frozen.

III. Play

- A. *Teams will referee their own games.* – If a decision can not be made, replay the point. If a question arises regarding a rule, contact the Site Supervisor before any play resumes.
- B. *Start of game* – Captains will meet before contest and determine who serves 1st. If contest goes to a third game, the captains will once again meet to determine service and side.
- C. *Game* – Played to (25) points, rally scoring. Every serve ends in a point for one of the teams. Teams do need to win by 2.
- D. *Match* – Best 2 out of 3 games.
- E. *Keeping score* – Teams may use the provided scorecards, or keep score in their own preferred way.
- F. *Time limit* – Matches will have a ONE-hour time limit (this includes any warm up your team wishes to take.) All matches will start and end on time. A game may not end on a tie. Teams must win by two.
- G. *Rotations* – Clockwise direction
- H. *Substitutions* – If a team has less than six players and a player arrives, that player may join at the next dead ball. The location of the substitution may be any position but the server. The subs position must remain the same throughout the game.
- I. *Team standings* – Team and League standings will not be kept.

IV. Miscellaneous

- A. *Disorderly conduct* – Any player or fan demonstrating disorderly conduct such as obscene language, and rude gestures will be asked to leave the

building without any prior warning. If the person does not leave, the match will be forfeited, and proper authorities will be called.

- B. *Food/Drink* – Will not be permitted in the gyms. Players who arrive who have thought to be drinking alcoholic beverages will be asked to leave.
- C. *Children* – Must be supervised at all times.

Clarifications:

- No Blocking serves (Must have hands together if contacted above head)
- Subs come in at the middle back position.
